AL SPARKS APPOINTED

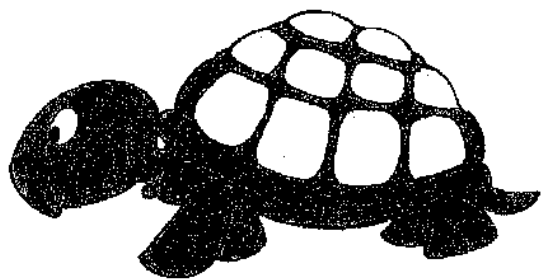
Jim Peppmuller has ably represented our Council as our representative to the St Mary Parish Community Life Commission for the past three years. Our thanks go to Jim for a job well done.

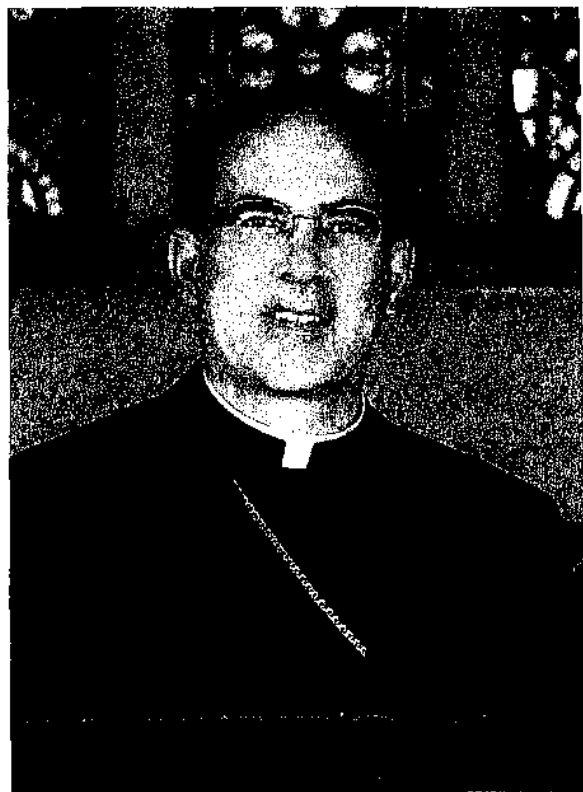
